CHATTAHOOCHEE, July 10, 2014 – During the City of Chattahoochee’s recent July 4th Celebration, an opportunity was provided for the community to support the Wounded Warrior Project® in honor of the brave servicemen and women who have willingly risked and sacrificed their lives to ensure our nation’s freedom and independence. To add to the support raised on July 4th, donations will continue to be received through the end of the July.

The Wounded Warrior Project® provides a variety of programs and services to veterans and service members (and their families) who have suffered physical or mental injury, illness, or wound during their military service on or after September 11, 2001. Since that time, over 52,000 servicemen and women have been physically injured. Statistically, for every soldier killed in action, seven are wounded.

Besides those with physical wounds, it is estimated that up to 400,000 endure the invisible wounds of war including combat-related stress, major depression, and post-traumatic stress disorder. In addition, 320,000 are estimated to live with the result of a traumatic brain injury while on deployment.
